# International Course on Research Ethics

## COURSE OVERVIEW

This international course is an overview of research ethics, focusing on the ethics of health research. This course will cover the following:

- a) Historical background, principles, and guidelines of research ethics
- b) Ethical considerations in health research such as those related to conflict of interest, vulnerability, risk and benefit evaluation, and informed consent
- c) Ethical issues and methodologies in different health research fields (clinical trials; animal research; genetic research; traditional medicine research; and epidemiological, behavioral, and social research) in the context of national, regional, and international collaborative research

## COURSE OBJECTIVES

The general objectives of this course are:

- a) Demonstrate a common understanding of the ethical principles in health research
- b) Utilize the ethical principles in addressing different considerations and issues related to various health research fields

## COURSE FORMAT

This course to a large extent will be organized in an interactive learning format where students and researchers will work on a number of case studies which illustrate the main points made in the lecture presentations. Background materials will be provided to the students and researchers.
