COURSE OVERVIEW

This international course is an overview of responsible research, focusing on good research practice, protocol development, research planning, data management, and publication of research results. This course will cover the following:

- a) Principles and guidelines of good research practice
- b) Initiating research: Responsible protocol writing and planning and setting-up of research
- c) Conducting research: Quality data management and research or scientific misconduct
- d) Reporting research: Publication ethics

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The general objectives of this course are:

- a) Demonstrate a common understanding of the principles of good research practice
- b) Utilize the principles of good research practice in the conduct of responsible research

COURSE FORMAT

This course to a large extent will be organized in an interactive learning format where students and researchers will work on a number of case studies which illustrate the main points made in the lecture presentations. Background materials will be provided to the students and researchers.
